CONTEXT AND OVERVIEW

The New Azerbaijan Party, led by President Ilham Aliyev, won a narrow victory in Azerbaijan's 2024 snap parliamentary election on September 1, securing 68 out of 125 seats, according to official results. This election was held two months earlier than scheduled to avoid conflicting with UN climate talks in Baku (COP29). The ruling party lost two seats compared to the previous parliament. In comparison, 44 seats were won by 'independents,' overwhelmingly coerced by the ruling regime and not opposing its policies in any meaningful way. Voting took place for the first time in Nagorno-Karabakh since 1994, symbolizing Azerbaijan's renewed control over the region.

On paper, the election was watched, with some 50 organizations conducting observer missions. While the vote was peaceful, the election period cannot be considered fully compliant with democratic standards, with the civil society and independent journalists harassed throughout the campaign, forced to emigrate, or arrested, and this election did not significantly alter the dominant position of Aliyev's party in parliament. The low voter turnout of 37% raised concerns about the legitimacy of the election process, symbolized a lack of interest by the voters given to real alternatives to the ruling regime, and no candidates accurately represented the political views and positions of the population. As discussed in this report, in addition to legitimate election observers from OSCE/ODIHR and OSCE PA, the regime made it particularly difficult for independent groups, especially domestic ones, to conduct observation. Senior Russian and Belarusian officials with ties to intelligence services – some sanctioned by the West, including for torturing democratic opposition - along with members of election commissions from the

Global South, were preferred by the regime over independent domestic observers. The invited foreign observers disregarded multiple electoral violations in exchange for a trip to Baku. The European Platform for Democratic Elections (EPDE) views them as fake observers. Additionally, many of the identified fake observers are members of parliamentary friendship groups with Azerbaijan, which EPDE considers a conflict of interest that impairs their ability to objectively assess elections.

EPDE agrees with ODIHR's critical assessment of the elections for several reasons. As mentioned above, the pre-election environment was marked by heavy restrictions on political freedoms, including freedom of expression, assembly, and association. Political opposition faced repression, and key candidates and activists were arrested or successfully pressured to withdraw from the race. Media access remained heavily restricted, favoring the ruling regime, while independent candidates were heavily sidelined. These factors alone affect the transparency and credibility of the elections, leading to EPDE's conclusion that they did not meet democratic standards, which is in line with the findings and conclusions presented by the Election Observation Mission of ODIHR.

Fake Observers

The fake observation phenomenon involves election monitoring by groups and individuals who lack independence and credibility. These missions often align with non-democratic regimes and issue favorable reports, even when elections have evident irregularities. They aim to legitimize flawed elections and counter criticism from credible organizations like OSCE/ODIHR, predominantly by domestic propaganda in the host country. Unlike legitimate observers, these groups offer little transparency and ignore international standards and election observation methodologies. Per EPDE's experience, fake observers focus on creating a false sense of legitimacy for non-democratic regimes, undermining efforts to ensure fair and democratic elections.

For its methodology, EPDE defines fake observers as individuals meeting any of the following criteria:

■ They participate in election observation missions organized by non-democratic entities.

■ They fail to denounce the elections as undemocratic despite official monitoring missions deeming them unfree, unfair, or conducted in violation of democratic standards.

- They make statements or comments that lend legitimacy to the elections, contradicting the assessments of credible democratic missions.
- Their presence can be confirmed by a picture or statement from a media outlet. Due to the detailed nature of local authoritarian propaganda, EPDE accepts Russian, Belarusian, and Azerbaijani state media as reliable sources solely for confirming the presence of such individuals.

EPDE has been actively uncovering fake observation missions, and EPDE's work includes thorough research and open-source investigations to reveal the role of these so-called observers. EPDE has exposed nearly 1000 individuals who undertook efforts to legitimize flawed elections in various countries between 2015 and 2024, including:

Findings from Regional Organizations

Multiple non-Western organizations, such as the Commonwealth of Independent States, sent accredited election observers to Azerbaijan and issued statements, their observations contrasting sharply with the assessments from independent local NGOs or OSCE/ODIHR and OSCE PA. Among them, the CIS mission, led by Leonid Anfimov, observed the parliamentary elections in Azerbaijan and concluded that the government made significant efforts to ensure transparent and open elections. The mission noted that the election day proceeded peacefully, without substantial violations, and praised the country for its effective organization. Anfimov also pointed out that the 'observers' from the CIS visited various regions across Azerbaijan and confirmed the legitimacy of the electoral process and its compliance with democratic standards¹.

In addition to the CIS mission, the Interparliamentary Assembly of CIS Member Nations (IPA-CIS) also observed the elections in Azerbaijan, visiting 145 polling stations nationwide. According to their findings, the elections were "conducted at a high organizational level," with observers able to work freely. They highlighted the advanced preparation of election commission members, the effective organization of voting, and video surveillance and document verification systems².

Andrey Yatskin, the First Deputy Chairperson of the Federation Council of Russia, coordinated the mission, which included representatives from Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, and Russia, as well as experts from the International Institute for Monitoring Democratic Development under the IPA-CIS³.

Russian senators, including Alexander Zhukov, Natalia Kosikhina, Alexander Terentyev, Ilyas Umakhanov, and Anatoly Shirokov also took part in monitoring missions on behalf of the Interparliamentary Assembly of the Commonwealth of Independent States, the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation, as well as the Parliamentary Assembly of the Union of Belarus and Russia, which covered various cities, including Hacigabul, Nakhchivan, Salyan, and Shirvan. They visited district commissions and polling stations, praising the work of the Central Election Commission of Azerbaijan for its preparation and organization of the elections. Yatskin commended the election process for ensuring the rights and freedoms of all participants, stating, "The elections complied with internationally recognized democratic principles and the constitutional and electoral legislation of the country."

Observers from these organizations visited 145 polling stations and monitored all stages of the election process, from opening the polls to counting the votes. They spoke highly of the high level of preparedness of the election commission members, the organization of the voting procedures, and the use of video surveillance and document verification systems by the polling station members. Yatskin emphasized that the elections took place amid "active competition" and provided "all necessary conditions for the observers to carry out their work." At a press conference in Baku on the 2nd of September, Yatskin reiterated the fair and transparent nature of the elections, underscoring that they adhered to the principles of free and fair elections.

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) also sent a mission to observe the elections. The OIC mission claims to have observed the electoral process in three stages: pre-poll preparations, polling day, and voting counting. According to their statement, after meeting with Azerbaijani electoral authorities and receiving briefings, the mission concluded that the elections were conducted in a transparent, free, and organized manner. In that statement, the OIC Secretary General, Hissein Brahim Taha, congratulated the people of Azerbaijan on the successful conduct of the elections, noting that the turnout demonstrated voters' commitment to exercising their political and civil rights, including in

the "liberated territories." The mission observed that voters were engaged, and the process upheld principles of transparency and fairness⁴.

The Organization of Turkic States (OTS) also deployed an observation mission of officials from the Secretariat and Central Election Commission representatives from OTS member states, observing the election process in Baku and the Absheron-Khizi region. The mission met with key figures in the Azerbaijani government, such as Mr. Mazahir Panahov, Chairperson of the Central Election Commission, to discuss the election's organization, including the participation of international and local observers. The OTS team monitored 36 polling stations and noted that the elections were carried out without interference from administrative or law enforcement authorities, ensuring the "free will of the people." The delegation emphasized that polling stations were well-prepared and accessible to people with disabilities. Per their statement, the OTS observers also participated in the vote-counting process in Baku and observed that it was conducted in compliance with national legislation. They highlighted the wide media coverage as a positive factor in the election's legitimacy. In conclusion, the OTS mission assessed the elections as "open and transparent" and aligned with national laws and international standards⁵.

The Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) observer mission, led by Nuran Niyazaliev and the SCO's Deputy Secretary-General, praised Azerbaijan's recent parliamentary elections as a significant step in the country's democratic development. According to Niyazaliev, the elections were conducted transparently and met the standards of Azerbaijan's constitution and electoral code. He highlighted that the voting process was calm, with no violations, external interference, or pressure on election officials. Niyazaliev emphasized the presence of local, public, and international observers, including media representatives, ensuring credibility and transparency. At a press conference on September 2, he expressed gratitude to Azerbaijan's Central Election Commission, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and other institutions for facilitating the SCO's work.

Key Findings from OSCE ODIHR and OSCE PA Election Observations

Unlike the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, the joint election observation mission from the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) and the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly (OSCE PA) was present and accredited by Azerbaijan's CEC. Led by Michael Creed, Special Coordinator of the OSCE short-term observers, and Lucie Potůčková, Head of the OSCE PA delegation, the mission deployed over 200 short-term observers across the country.

In preparation for the elections, the mission engaged in extensive pre-election briefings with civil society organizations, political parties, and officials from Azerbaijan's Central Election Commission. Mr. Creed emphasized the thoroughness of these briefings, stating, "The election commission has provided us with particularly detailed information, which has been crucial in helping us stay well-informed about the elections."

On election day, OSCE observers were stationed at multiple polling locations, monitoring the process from the polls opening to the vote count. According to their conclusions, technically, the voting process was carried out according to Azerbaijan's legal framework, which they said "does not meet international standards or OSCE commitments for democratic elections," and observed "serious irregularities and omissions of important safeguards were observed, particularly in the vote count, raising questions about the integrity of the process." Additionally, the mission identified broader concerns regarding the general electoral environment, which they believed undermined the integrity of the elections.

One primary issue the mission raised was the lack of genuine political competition. The ruling New Azerbaijan Party's dominance created an environment with limited options for voters, particularly regarding

opposition candidates. Additionally, the media landscape was another critical concern. The mission noted that opposition parties faced considerable difficulties gaining access to mainstream media, severely restricting their ability to reach voters. Media coverage was heavily biased in favor of the ruling party, further limiting political pluralism.

Ditmir Bushati, Head of ODIHR's long-term election observation mission, remarked, "Despite the efficiency of the process, these conditions did not allow elections to be held in line with democratic standards. We stand ready to support the authorities in implementing our long-standing recommendations to improve the overall process for the good of all citizens." This sentiment echoed throughout the mission's findings, as they observed multiple barriers that limited equal participation for opposition candidates.

Other issues included concerns over the candidate registration process, which disproportionately affected opposition members, and the apparent use of state resources in favor of the ruling party, which cast further doubts on the fairness of the campaign environment. Despite the smooth technical running of the polling stations, the mission assessed that the elections did not meet many international standards and good practices for free and fair elections⁸.

Baiba Veisa observed^{9,10} Azerbaijan's September 2024 snap parliamentary election as vice chairperson¹¹ of the Central Election Commission of Latvia. She has been appointed^{12,13} on February 2023, as a nominee of the United List (Apvienotā saraksta) party¹³. "All the stations I visited were equipped according to the law. My colleagues from the commission did not inform me about any violations of the law, and I myself did not observe them. Of course, I was happy to see a large number of young people in the city."

"We really hope that friendly relations between Latvia and Azerbaijan will continue in the future. Our official delegations come to Azerbaijan quite often, and of course we expect delegations from Azerbaijan to come to Latvia as well."

"Baş çəkdiyim bütün məntəqələr qanunvericiliyə uyğun şəkildə təchiz olunmuşdu. Komissiyadan olan həmkarlarım mənə heç bir qanun pozuntusu barədə məlumat vermədilər, elə özüm də onları müşahidə etməmişəm. Təbii ki, şəhərdə çoxlu sayda gənci görməyim məni sevindirdi."

"Biz həqiqətən də Latviya ilə Azərbaycan arasında dostluq əlaqələrinin gələcəkdə də davam edəcəyinə ümid edirik. Rəsmi nümayəndə heyətlərimiz kifayət qədər tez-tez Azərbaycana gəlir və təbii ki, Azərbaycandan da Latviyaya nümayəndə heyətlərinin gələcəyini gözləyirik."

EPDE has contacted Ms. Veisa for confirmation and the context of her quote. She replied her comments were factual with regard to the narrow scope of her observation and the lack of reported context may have presented her as validating the entire election process. She reiterated her strong support for democratic values and transparency. She stated that travel costs have been covered by the Latvian CEC, while local accommodation was covered by the local CEC "as per official invitation".

Naike Gruppioni, born in Bologna, is an Italian politician who has been a member of the Chamber of Deputies¹⁵ since 2022. With a degree in Business Administration, she had an entrepreneurial career, including serving as vice president¹⁶ of her family's company, Sira Industrie, until 2022. Naike Gruppioni is also the Vice President of the Italy USA Foundation. She entered politics in the 2022 general elections¹⁷, representing the Azione party and switching¹⁸ to Italia Viva in May 2023. Elected for the XIX legislature, she holds positions in the Chamber of Deputies. Naike Gruppioni had already¹⁹ observed the February 2024 snap presidential election in Azerbaijan and was strongly criticized^{20,21}. "This is the second time I have observed the election process in Azerbaijan. One of the characteristics of your country that amazes me is the desire of the Azerbaijani people to actively participate in these elections. People's passion is the manifestation of democracy." Italian deputy Naike Gruppioni said these words in an interview to AZERTAC.²²

"I have been to several polling stations since morning. Based on my observations at the polling stations, I can say that the election process was organized very carefully and transparency was ensured. I was pleased to see young people among the voters. At the same time, the participation of both young men and women in organizational work shows that the people of Azerbaijan are interested in building their own successful future," said the deputy, adding that we politicians always like to talk about human rights. "However, I have witnessed the protection of human rights here today. I was a live witness of the rights given to women, especially during the election process in Azerbaijan. Women are very active in organizing elections and monitoring the election process. This is a clear example of the rights given to women."22

"Artıq ikinci dəfədir Azərbaycanda seçki prosesini müşahidə edirəm. Ölkənizdə məni heyrətə gətirən xüsusiyyətlərdən biri Azərbaycan xalqının bu seçkilərdə fəal iştirak etmək istəyidir. "Mən səhər saatlarından başlayaraq artıq bir neçə seçki məntəqəsində olmusam. Secki məntəqələrində apardığım müşahidələrə əsasən deyə bilərəm ki, seçki prosesi çox diggətlə təşkil olunub və şəffaflıq təmin edilib. Mən seçicilər arasında gəncləri görməkdən məmnun oldum. Evni zamanda, təskilati islərdə həm gənclərin, həm də xanımların istirakı onu göstərir ki, Azərbaycan xalqı öz uğurlu gələcəyini gurmaq üçün maraq göstərir", – deyən deputat bildirib ki, biz siyasətçilər daim insan hüquqlarından danışmağı xoşlayırıq. "Ancaq mən bu gün burada insan hüquqlarının qorunmasının canlı şahidi oldum. Xüsusilə Azərbaycanda seçki prosesində aadınlara verilən hüauaların canlı sahidi oldum. Oadınlar həm seckilərin təskilində, həm də secki prosesinə nəzarətdə çox fəal iştirak edirlər. Bu isə qadınlara verilmiş hüquqların bariz nümunəsidir."²²

Duarte Pacheco is a member²³ of the social-democratic party PSD (Partido Social Democrata) and has been a fixture in the Portuguese Parliament since his first election²⁴ in 1991. In January 2024, the electoral alliance Aliança Democrática, to which the PSD belongs, decided not to list Duarte Pacheco anymore for the next term²⁵. I felt the joy of people in Shusha. While I was there. I noticed that the voters were eager to come and cast their votes. I should mention that this was the first election I observed abroad and there were no surprises. The election was held in Azerbaijan in the same way as it was held in Great Britain."35

"In the cities of Fuzuli and Khankendi, which were freed from occupation, where we observed the voting process, all conditions have been created for the citizens to express their will easily." APA reports that Sergey Khomenko, Deputy Chairman of the Republican Council of the National Assembly of the Republic of Belarus, said this in his statement to journalists. He said that as a result of his observations, it was concluded that the voting process in Azerbaijan was organized in accordance with the Election Code.¹⁷¹

"We visited the polling stations in the territories that were liberated from the occupation and are currently being restored. We are talking about the cities of Fuzuli and Khankendi. We will also be in the city of Shusha. "We want to congratulate the Azerbaijani people on another brilliant conduct of elections to the highest legislative body," Umakhanov said. "We are communicating, including with observers, who confirm the absence of any violations. The election campaign has been organized by the Central Electoral Commission of Azerbaijan at a very decent level. We have confirmed this more than once, being at elections in Azerbaijan. In general, our mission, consisting of 40 people, will visit a fairly large number of polling stations. In the evening. we will summarize the results, gather our monitoring group in order to share our impressions and prepare our conclusion. We will be able to announce the preliminary results already at a press conference on Monday. But we will be able to officially publish them only after the Constitutional Court officially recognizes the elections as having taken place and approves the results. We are very pleased with how the election process is organized in Azerbaijan. Everything corresponds to the best democratic standards, so we have no comments on the election process today."200

Our group of international observers, part of the common mission of the Commonwealth of Independent States, has long since begun work on understanding the electoral process in Azerbaijan. First, we made a legal conclusion, and it confirms that all normative documents governing the electoral processes in Azerbaijan comply with all the best accepted world standards.²⁰¹

"The parliamentary elections in Azerbaijan were held in a transparent environment, and we did not record any negative aspects." a Russian observer. Director of the Center for Political Studies, Sergey Markov told Report. Markov noted that he did not see any negative phenomena while observing the voting process. "Of course, the voter turnout was not the same as in the presidential elections. But this is understandable," Markov said. The political scientist congratulated the Azerbaijani people on holding parliamentary elections throughout the entire country: "This is an important historic event. I believe that the new parliament will justify the trust."213

Igor Korotchenko is another analyst close to the Russian regime, general director of the think-tank Caspian Institute for Strategic Studies, and publisher of the magazine National Defense^{217,218}. He specializes in defense, security and intelligence issues. In February 2012, Igor Korotchenko was appointed as a member of the Public Council under Russia's Ministry of Defense²¹⁸.

Russia's Foreign Intelligence Service (SVR) awarded Igor Korotchenko with a Certificate "For great personal contribution to strengthening and developing cooperation with the Foreign Intelligence Service of Russia"²¹⁸. Igor Korotchenko is a member²¹⁹ of the hardline Russian nationalist Rodina party and was listed as its Chairperson of the Party Council on National Security²¹⁹ and a member of the Presidium of the Political Council²¹⁹. Korotchenko noted that the election results will demonstrate Azerbaijan's high democratic standards to Western powers.²²¹

"The West, in particular countries like France, which is particularly zealous in criticizing Azerbaijan, have much to learn from the Azerbaijani electoral system. The modern political system of France is totalitarian and committed to neocolonial policies, setting an example of injustice, while modern Azerbaijan sets standards of justice for the West," he said.²²¹

The expert [Korotchenko] stressed that Azerbaijan would continue to confidently move forward together with friendly countries, including the Russian Federation.²²¹

"Having visited about 15 polling stations in Baku and the suburbs yesterday, we as a group of independent Russian observers can note the clear organization of the election process, the high level of training of the members of the election commission, the impeccable organization of the voting process, which was honest, fair, legitimate and met all the criteria of existing norms of election technologies in the world." he noted.²²⁴

Korotchenko emphasized that in this regard, Azerbaijan once again demonstrated the perfection of its political system and its stability. "In today's turbulent world, Azerbaijan is an island of stability, prosperity and confident movement forward. This is primarily ensured, I repeat, by the political system of Azerbaijan, which responds to existing challenges and is the foundation for the forward movement of the Azerbaijani people under the leadership of the president," the expert said.²²⁴







RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DEMOCRATIC SAFEGUARDS

In the context of fake observers coming to legitimize elections in Azerbaijan, EPDE proposes several calls to action to discourage the participation of fake observers, increase transparency, and hold individuals and organizations accountable for undermining democratic processes and discrediting the integrity of the democratic institutions and democratic governments they represent:

- EPDE calls on international organizations, political parties, and media outlets to regularly check EPDE's list of fake observers at fakeobservers.org. Our database aims to deter participation by those who, for whatever reason or gain blackmail, financial, or pure naivety legitimize undemocratic elections.
- 2. EPDE calls on key democratic institutions, such as the European Union, U.S. Congress, or the Council of Europe, to publicly denounce and condemn participation in fake observation missions as harmful to global democratic standards. EPDE calls on democratic governments and international organizations to strengthen the diplomatic and political pressure on Azerbaijan to ensure they only invite credible and impartial election observers from organizations complying with international standards of election observation, such as OSCE/ODIHR, OSCE PA, or the PACE.
- 3. The EU and other democratic countries should impose targeted sanctions or legal measures against third-country nationals participating in fake observation missions. Such measures could include travel bans, asset freezes, or bans on representing their countries in bilateral and multilateral engagements. This includes exclusion

- from conferences, academic exchanges, and any form of international cooperation based in the EU or other democratic nations.
- 4. EPDE encourages media outlets globally to raise awareness and educate citizens about the dangers of fake election observation and the role certain individuals play in legitimizing fraudulent elections abroad to reduce their credibility and discourage others from participating.
- 5. EPDE urges election monitoring bodies and domestic election commissions globally to adopt stricter transparency measures. These should include publishing a complete, detailed list of all observers, their affiliations, and their observation experience to simplify the identification and discreditation of election observers.
- 6. Additionally, EPDE calls on institutions and national and regional parliaments to establish and implement laws and clear ethical guidelines for individuals, particularly elected officials, participating in election observation missions. These guidelines should emphasize impartiality and non-alignment with authoritarian regimes. EPDE stresses that violating these guidelines should lead to exclusion from future international democratic election observation missions.
- 7. Finally, EPDE calls on democratic countries and institutions to introduce career and financial disincentives for individuals participating in these activities, such as barring them from holding positions in publicly funded democratic organizations, NGOs, or international bodies.
